purchase one of these cookbooks for \$5. To buy one, contact Pat Brhel at 539-9928 or Pastor Dan Phillips at 319-5179.

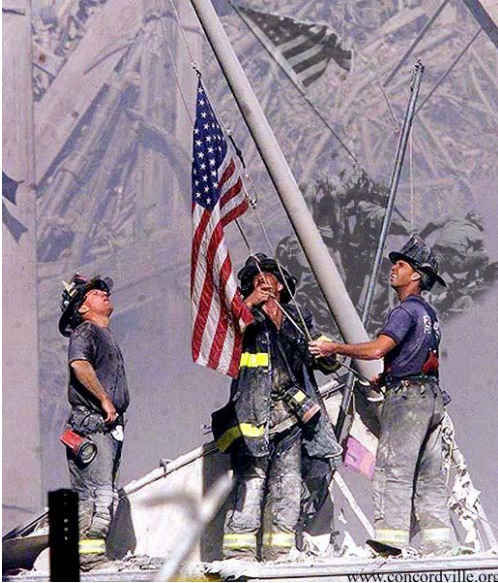
STARTING OVER!
